 - b. Non-Voting Representatives
 - a. Non-voting representatives to the Executive Board have a 2-year term. As of May 1, 2021, new representatives will be chosen.
 - b. The Management Committee will present the board with the representative for the small subscribers and the large subscribers.

 - 1. Northshore Utility District Northshore UD serves Kirkland and Kenmore. Both cities have a very good working relationship with the utility district
 - 2. WSDOT will start as a regional service then reevaluate expansion.
